Nga: I don't have enough money to buy this book now!

Tan: Don't worry. I **will lend** you some.

II. GRAMMAR

WILL vs. BE GOING TO



* WILL + bare-infinitive:

* BE GOING TO + infinitive

Mai: Lan's studying very hard. I think she **will pass** the next exam.

Hoa: And I hope that she **will get** high marks.

Quan: I know she **won't have** any difficulty.

WILL/ WON'T + bare infinitive:

I'm sure (that).....

I think (that).....

I hope (that).....

I know (that).....
